Hearing other people's questions, as well as doubts, and inspiring stories of their experience with Jesus and the hope and trust they have in him was so inspiring. I learned that I didn't need to feel shame for not being "perfect" and that today was a new day to start my faith journey. And that's okay and great!

It was only through connecting to other passionate people in their faith journey that I understood what it means to have a relationship with Jesus, and that God loves me so much that he literally gave himself for me! God really uses other people, especially Alpha, to bring me into a deeper relationship with Jesus. I love this verse about how we can only understand God's love together with others.
